RE: Daily Fresh Food Service Fuel Levy – Effective 23rd May 2022

The Foodservice sector has seen dramatic change around ongoing fuel costs in relation to the distribution sector and Daily Fresh Food Service has encountered an immediate effect on the viability around its distribution and delivery model.

With fuel costs contributing significantly towards our day-to-day service, it is imperative that we implement a “Fuel Levy Formula” effective Monday 23rd May 2022, that provides a fair and transparent calculation for the recovery of these volatile cost movements which is aligned with industry standards. This average price will be measured from the fuel check website in relation to diesel fuel at; www.fuelcheck.nsw.gov.au/app

Daily Fresh will formulate the fuel levy based on the average weekly fuel price. This means that we are only seeking to recover the actual extra cost of fuel to our business and not attempting to improve profit margins via a fuel levy.

The weekly fuel price will be monitored every Monday for the week ahead and the levy will reflect on your invoice. When required the fuel levy will be adjusted up or down according to the calculation shown below.

We thank you for your understanding in this matter and look forward to continuing to supply you a quality and sustainable distribution service.
